I. INTRODUCTION

Vijaya College of Nursing is functioning under Vijaya Educational Trust of India, established in the year 2005 and is attached to Vijaya Hospital, which is a 300 bedded Super specialty Hospital. The college campus is situated 3 kilometers away from Kottarakkara town in Kollam District, Kerala.

Overview of the B.Sc. Nursing Course

- This college offers 4years B.Sc. Nursing Degree Course which is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS)
- Admission process of this college is done through college website. Application fee is Rs.1000/-.
- This prospectus contains the rules and regulations governing the selection and admission process for B.Sc Nursing course for the academic year 2026-2027.
- This prospectus is subjected to modifications, additions and deletion as deemed necessary by the college authorities and in accordance with the directions of Kerala University of Health Sciences and Government of Kerala

II. NUMBERS OF SEATS

The annual intake for B.Sc. Nursing Course is 85 seats. Candidates admitted to the course shall pay the fees as fixed by the Government of Kerala/Fee Regulatory Committee and approved by the competent authorities.

III. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Academic Qualification

1. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Examinations, Kerala State, or any equivalent examination recognized by any university in Kerala, with:
 - Minimum aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in the second year of Plus Two examination, are eligible for admission.

Relaxation in Marks

- a. Candidates belonging to SEBC (Socially and Economically Backward Classes) in Kerala, whose annual family income is below ₹6 lakhs, are eligible for a relaxation of 5% marks.
- b. Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.
- c. Candidates claiming relaxation in marks must produce valid supporting documents/certificates from the competent authority.

There shall be no reservation of seats for SEBC/SC/ST candidates under the Management Quota.

Eligibility Certificate

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from outside Kerala shall produce:

- Certificate of Recognition
- Equivalency Certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur.

These certificates must be submitted at the time of admission/interview.

Age Limit

1. Applicants should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December 2026. No relaxation in the minimum age will be permitted.
2. Birth Certificate showing the date of birth must be produced at the time of admission.

IV. HOW TO APPLY

Steps of Application Submission

All applicants must complete the following steps:

Steps for Online Application

1. Visit the official website: www.vijayacollegeofnursing.org.
2. Click on the "Apply Now" link.
3. Enter the student's Aadhaar Number and mobile number.

4. Verify the OTP received on the registered mobile number and proceed to the application form.
 5. Fill the student's personal details and upload a recent passport-size photograph.
 6. Enter the student's contact details.
 7. Provide the parent details.
 8. Enter the academic details and upload scanned copies of the required self-attested certificates. (SSLC and Plus Two Certificates)
 9. Read and accept the declaration, and upload with applicant's signature.
 10. Review all the information entered, submit the application, and complete the online payment process.
 11. Candidate can download the application form if required
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Candidates should submit only one application. Multiple applications submitted by the same candidate for the same course will result in rejection of all subsequent applications.

Incomplete applications or applications containing false or irrelevant information will be rejected.

Application Fee

1. The application fee is ₹1000/-.
2. Payment should be made through online mode.
3. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.
4. Only completed and paid applications will be considered for admission.

V. PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

Merit List

- a. The sanctioned intake for the academic year 2026–2027 is 85 seats.
- b. Out of the total seats, 50% (43 seats) will be allotted through LBS Centre/Government allotment.
- c. The remaining 50% (42 seats) will be filled up by the Management strictly on the basis of merit considering the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
- d. Among the Management Quota seats, 15% (12 seats) shall be reserved for eligible NRI candidates as per G.O.(Ms) No. 243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.
- e. Original certificates/documents must be produced at the time of admission.
- f. Duration of the course: - Duration of the course is 4 years (8 Semester)

1. Proof of age and date of birth.
2. Certificate and Mark list of SSLC / 10th Std.
3. Certificate and Mark list of Plus Two / 12th Std
4. Certificate of conduct and character from the institution last studied.
5. Certificate proof of SEBC/OBC/SC/ST status obtained from the Tahsildar concerned (if applicable)
6. Transfer Certificate
7. Course certificate from the Head of Institution last studied
8. Eligibility Certificates from Kerala University of Health Sciences, in case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than Higher Secondary Examination / Vocational Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE/ICSE/ISC and / or Degree from other Universities or Boards (if needed)

9. Nativity Certificate, if applicable
10. Copy of ID Proof (Aadhaar/Voters ID/Passport)
11. Copy of online application.
12. Passport Size photographs (10 nos)
13. Migration certificate from the concerned institution.

Additional documents Required for NRI Candidates

1. Indian Embassy Attested NRI Certificate of the sponsor
2. Indian Embassy Attested Employment Certificate of the sponsor (The attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where employment visa is stamped)
3. Indian Embassy Attested Passport Front- and Back-Page Copy
4. Indian Embassy Attested Valid Visa Copy of the sponsor (Arabic visa to be translate in English)
5. Indian Embassy Attested Sponsorship Affidavit/Declaration of the Sponsor (The candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs.200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all the expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the sponsor)
6. Relationship Certificate from Village Officer/Tahsildar Relationship with the sponsor should comply with:
 - GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dated 22.05.2013
 - KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/KUHS/2014 dated 12.06.2014

Resolution of Tie in Merit List

In the event of a tie in total marks:

1. Marks obtained in Biology will be considered first.
2. If the tie still persists, marks in Chemistry and Physics will be considered.
3. If the tie remains unresolved, the elder candidate will be given preference.

Validity of Merit List

- The published merit list shall remain valid as per the directions of the competent authority.
 - Inclusion in the merit list does not guarantee admission unless the candidate satisfies all eligibility conditions.
 - Furnishing false information or documents will lead to cancellation of admission and may invite legal action.
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VI. SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Selection of candidates will be based strictly on the rank list prepared from the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

The rank list will be published on the official college website.

VII. ADMISSION AND PAYMENT OF FEES

- Selected candidates will be informed regarding the date and time of admission through the official website.
- Candidates must pay the first-year fees at the time of admission.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Discontinuation of Course

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court."

Hostel Facility

Separate hostel facilities are available for girl students.

VIII. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Anti-Ragging

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited inside the college and Hostel.

Any student found involved in ragging will be subjected to disciplinary and legal action as per the Anti-Ragging Act, Government regulations, and the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

The student may also be expelled from the institution.

2. Use of Mobile Phones

Use of mobile phones by students inside the college campus is prohibited. Mobile Phone will be provided for the hostel students under the discretion of Principal or Warden

Violation of this rule will result in strict disciplinary action.

3. General Instructions

Any matter not specifically covered in this prospectus shall be decided by the Controller of Admissions.
